	RE:	UPDATE: Selective Service Status Statement Requirement - New Guidance

Effective immediately, institutions may begin using this updated guidance on confirming whether a male student is registered for Selective Service. This guidance will also be included in the upcoming distribution of the annual program guidelines.

- The institution can save the Selective Service registration confirmation directly from the <u>SSS.gov website</u> to serve as the student's official, signed statement on record.
- No statement or documentation is needed for the applicable award year when the ISIR confirms that a student is under the age of 18, even if the student turns 18 during that year.
